RTA Black Points System

The **RTA Black Points System** in Dubai is designed to promote safer driving habits and reduce road accidents. It works by assigning penalty points to drivers who violate traffic rules, encouraging more responsible behavior on the roads.

How the Black Points System Works

Each traffic violation carries a certain number of <u>black points</u>. When a driver commits an offense — such as speeding, running a red light, or using a phone while driving — points are added to their license.

- Minor offenses may add 2-4 black points.
- Major violations can result in up to 23 black points.

If a driver accumulates **24 black points**, their driving license may be **suspended** temporarily, and they may need to attend traffic awareness courses before reinstatement.

How to Check Your Black Points

You can easily check your RTA black points through:

- 1. The **Dubai Police website or mobile app**.
- 2. The **RTA Dubai app** by entering your driving license number.
- 3. Visiting an **RTA Customer Happiness Center** for assistance.

How to Reduce or Remove Black Points

Drivers can reduce black points by:

- Attending RTA-approved awareness courses.
- Maintaining a clean record for a certain period.
- Avoiding repeated offenses.
